A well-developed leader and analytical communicator, you will provide professional expertise in radiation protection, chemical and biological safety, and environmental health and safety (industrial hygiene). You will manage radiation exposure levels through an effective ALARA program. This role calls for a Bachelor or Master of Science or Applied Science in Chemistry or a related major with additional courses in radiation protection, as well as professional certification in industrial/occupational hygiene (CIH or ROH). You have 7 years' experience in the field of full spectrum, open-source radiation protection and chemical safety, including regulatory compliance and prevention program development. A detailed knowledge of relevant acts, legislation and regulations is essential, as is the ability to identify and evaluate occupational and environmental health and safety risk factors involving radiation, chemical and biological agents. Good management, report-writing and investigative skills, and familiarity with auditing and risk-management principles, as well as word-processing, database, spreadsheet, presentation and graphic software are expected.
